- DO NOT BREAK UP DOMESTIC ARGUMENTS
- KEEP CAR KEYS IN YOUR HAND AND BETWEEN YOUR FINGERS WHEN WALKING TO YOUR CAR.
- ALWAYS KNOCK ON THE DOOR BEFORE ENTERING A HOME.
- IDENTIFY YOURSELF TO THOSE INSIDE.
- AVOID WALKING THROUGH A CROWD.
- CHECK WEATHER ALERTS
